It has been a pleasure working with your RMA field crew responsible for construction of the Consolidated Fitness Center project located at Vandenberg Air Force Base, CA.

Your team's professionalism, attention to detail, and flexibility in accommodating the needs of multiple base agencies was paramount to successful execution of this project. We could always count on Mac Sheikh, Nate Christensen, Chris Martin, and Jim Wilson to comply with strict Air Force and Department of Defense regulations.

Furthermore, RMA exhibited creativity by recommending and implementing innovative approaches during construction. For example, RMA was a key part of the team that made a decision to substitute large boulders and buried telephone poles in lieu of an Anti-Terrorism/Force Protection earthen berm and ditch barrier around the entire facility; the boulders and buried telephone poles drastically improved the aesthetics of the project site while still satisfying Department of Defense blast protection standards. The alternative barrier also saved dozens of trees that would have died if the earthen berm were constructed per the original design.
