

During the design process of the AT/FP perimeter fences, RMA implemented a creative alternate fence design, which was comparable in cost, yet provided an increased level in protection to allow for the potential of increased security demands in the future by providing a State Department K-8 rated fence in lieu of the lesser AT/FP requirements.

Maintaining a secure site during construction to ensure no unauthorized entry was mandatory during the construction phase of these projects. RMA installed a temporary eight-foot tall perimeter security fence sufficient enough to deter unauthorized entry and conceal the Base as well as a temporary secondary internal six-foot project fence to provide safety precautions for base personnel from inadvertently entering the job site. Furthermore, because of the highly visible locations of these projects, RMA took extra measures to ensure each project site was cleaned daily so as to be presentable to the Base personnel and top brass. All five projects were completed with well coordinated minimal disruption to base operations, within budget, ahead of schedule. Most impressive of all was RMA's constant attention to safety.
