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RMA Breaks Ground at Cannon Air Force Base

Anaheim, Calif. (June 22) - **RMA Land Construction, Inc., (RMA)** participated in the official groundbreaking ceremony at the site of the new Child Development Center at Cannon AFB, Clovis, New Mexico on June 18. Representatives from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the 27th Special Operations Wing Command, with the help of the children on base, broke ground at the five acre site to mark the start of construction.

Funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, the \$7.96 million contract consists of the design and construction of a single-story, 23,236 SF Child Development Center to accommodate 158 children ranging in age from six weeks through five years. The facility will feature classrooms and outdoor playground areas that provide a safe and healthy environment for early childhood development and preschool programs. Scheduled to open in April 2011, the center will meet Air Force requirements and obtain the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED® Silver certification for sustainability.
